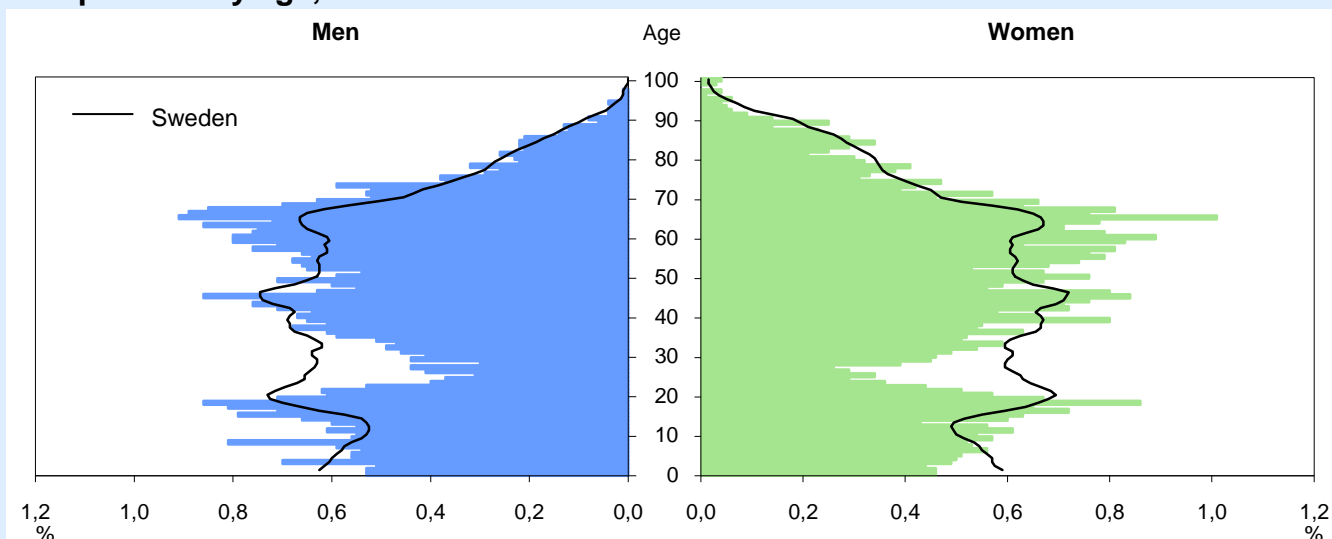

Population by age, 2010



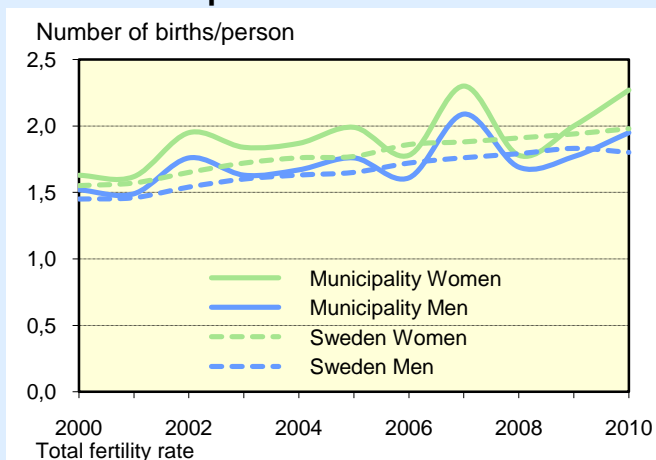

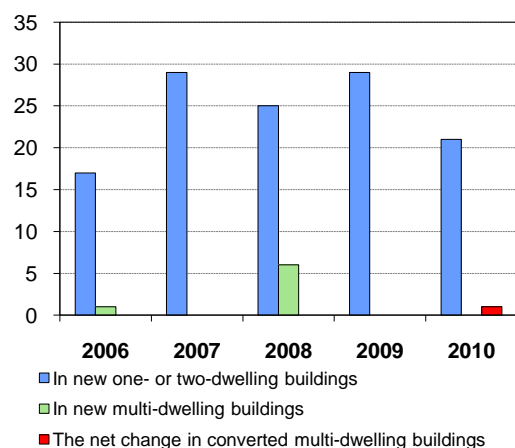

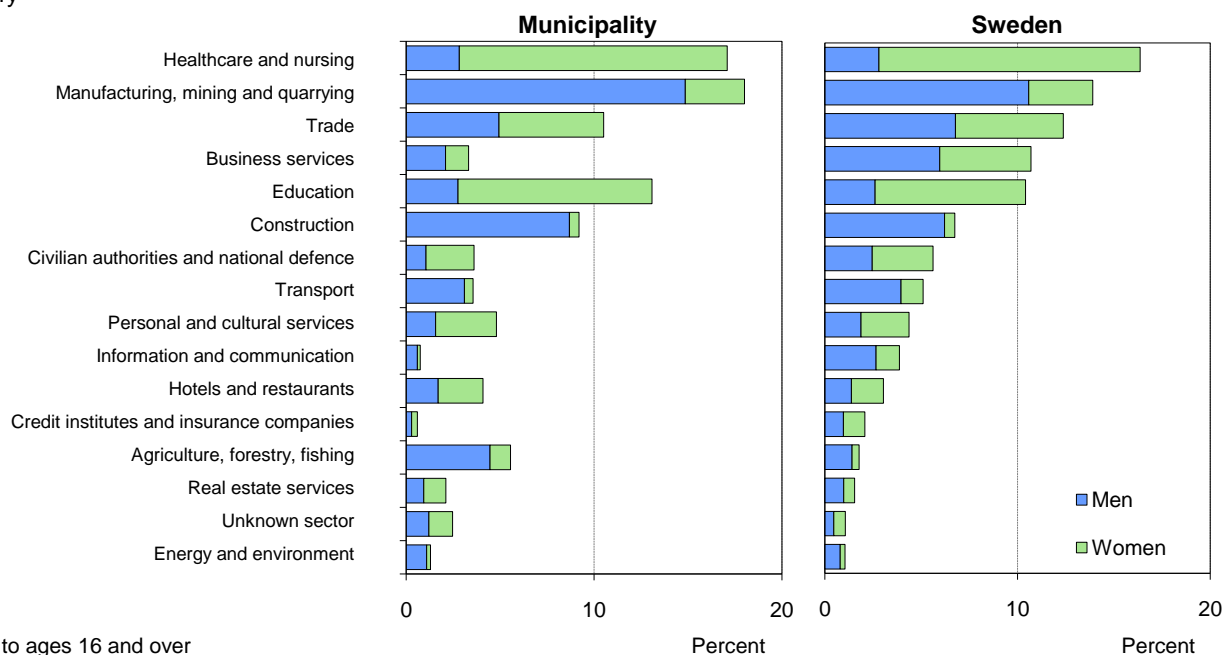

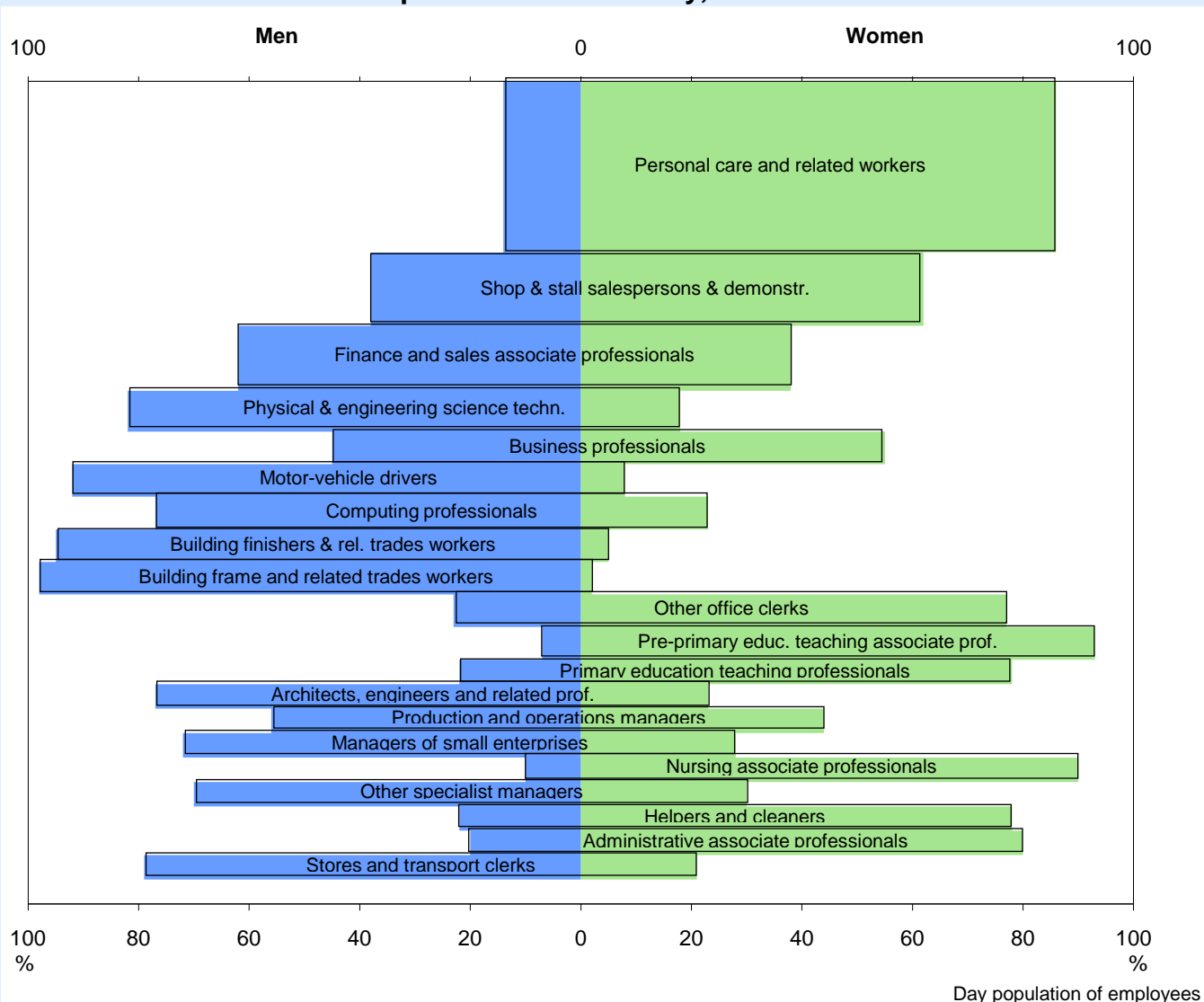

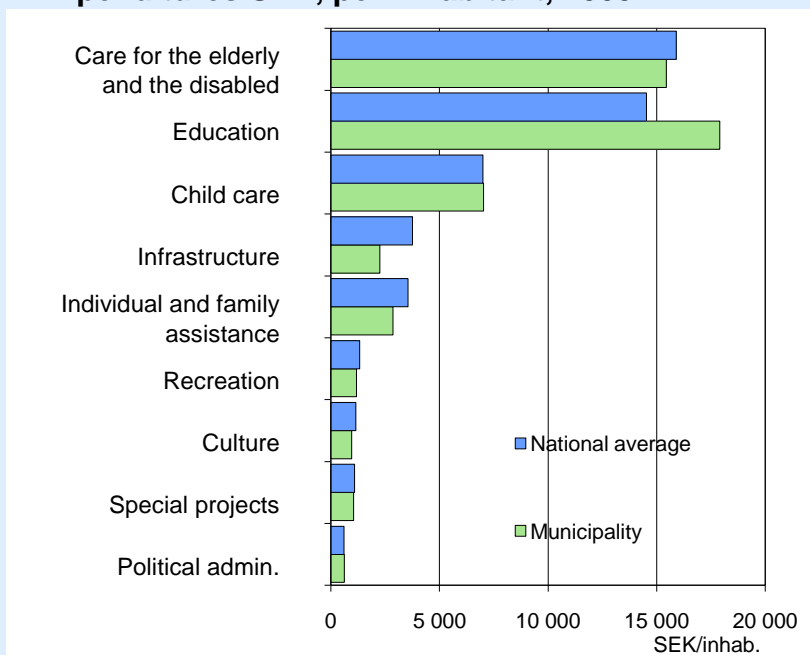
