

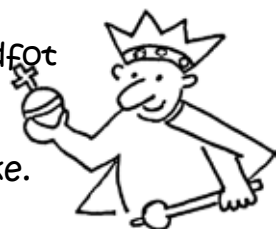
Easy to find, easy to guess about the Middle Ages

2. A snake



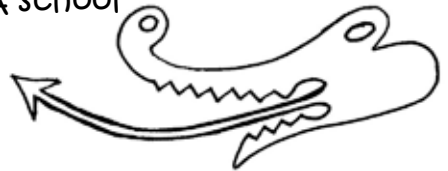
3. This handsome knight tours during the medieval festival "Söderköpings Gästabud" in september. He stands in front of a 50 m high building. What kind of building?

5. Here, nearby the smallest square in town there's a lot of nice old houses. In the Middle Ages a special group lived here in houses with a wall around. Who?

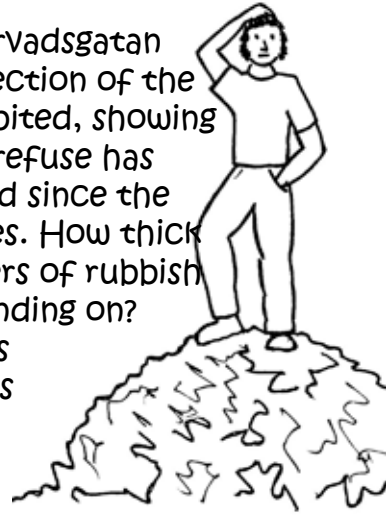
1. Prisoners

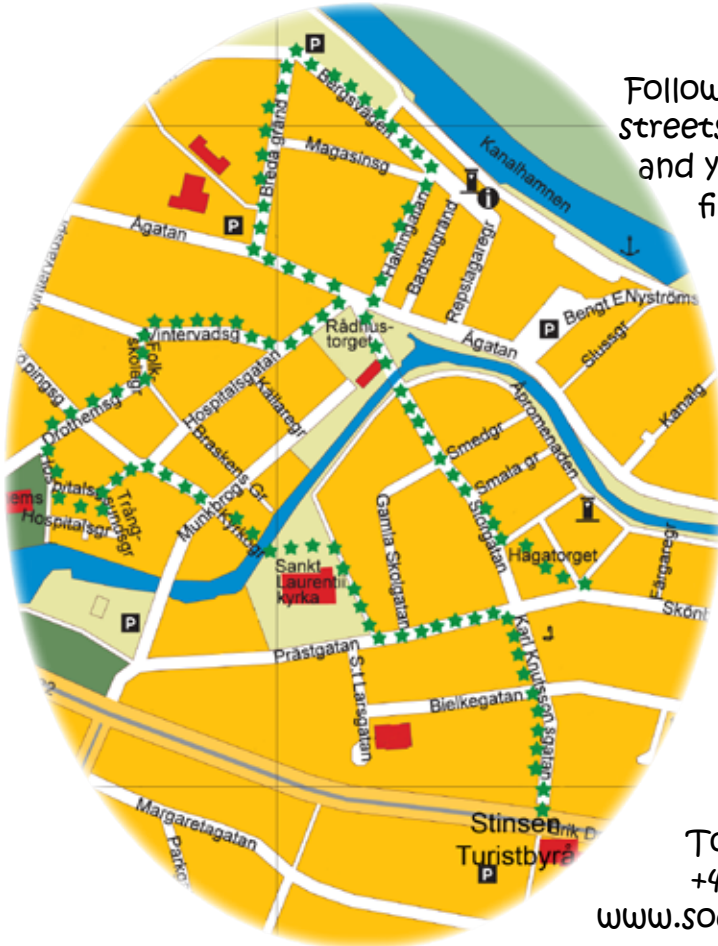
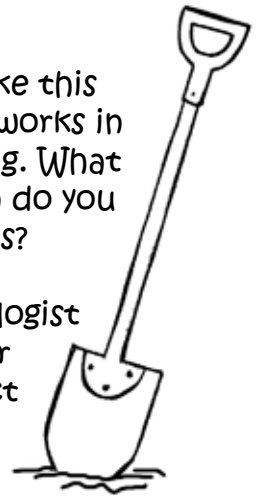
- 1. A pair of cracow shoes
